### Agenda

#### *Camp Lassiter Updates and Planning*

Amy Floyd is working with Coach Fischer, as well as training and guiding new chairs, Kelley and Jen. They are meeting behind the scenes with the coaches, who want to take a more active role (as will the cheerleaders). Due to work commitments, both Jen and Kelley won't be able to be at Camp the entire time so the Board will need to be present. Allie will be there for used clothing boutique. Signup Genius is the best way to track and recruit volunteers.

Kelley has all of the used boutique clothes. She's cleaned out old stuff – we'll need to help her sort them and have them ready to lay out at camp. Coach Fischer is only having Seniors donate old clothes. The Camp Lassiter chairs are taking control of planning. Temp checks and masks will be required (following Cobb County guidelines).

We already have 50 people signed up for Camp Lassiter already (plus Lassiter Jr Trojan Cheer – 29 girls)
